Lesson 1 September 12, 2022 Modern Hand Evaluation

Join Donna for a look at the modern methods of hand evaluation. Played long ago? This class will bring you up to speed with long-suit points and short-suit points. The class materials will also share with you the secret of shape bidding like the experts.

Lesson 2 September 19, 2022 Responder's Choices & Hand Evaluation

This class will present responder's ranges and priorities when responding to major and minor suit opening bids. Short-suit hand evaluation are discussed along with length points without support. Donna's award-winning Responder's Choices Chart is included with the materials.

Lesson 3 September 26, 2022 Opener's Rebids

This is the most important bidding class you will ever take! We all know how to open the bidding and how to respond...but when it gets back to us as opener, we start looking at the ceiling for guidance. This class solves the rebid mystery as opener by focusing on shape bidding.

Jacoby Transfers helps find 5-3 major-suit fits over notrump openers. Donna will walk you through follow-up rebids, signing off in a minor and handling interference.

Lesson 7 November 7, 2022 Modern Overcalls

Overcalls are our way to get in the Opener and Responders Auction. There are four types of overcalls. Can you name them? If not, join this fun-filled class as we explore the different types of overcalls and responding to them.

Lesson 8 November 14, 2022 Modern Takeout Doubles

The takeout double is another toy for the intervenor (opponent of the opening bidder) to enter the auction and compete for the contract. How do you know if it is a takeout double or penalty double?
